In addition, we also partner with several school sites to provide childcare and after school programs.

- 5 Prime Time (formerly 6-to-6, the City's after-school program) before and after school sites, serving more than 500 youth
- 5 licensed childcare sites for before and after school childcare, serving 350 youth

Community Outreach Programs:

Mission Valley YMCA's *Physical Education Outreach (P.E. Outreach) Program* reaches more than 2,300 students during the school day, providing them with opportunities like free swim and gymnastics lessons. The students are bussed to the YMCA, participate in activities, and are taken back to school.

The *PRYDE (Prevention, Recreation, Youth, Diversity, Education) Program* serves more than 100 kids through after school programming targeted at those children most at-risk of gang involvement or drug use. The program continues to provide “at-risk youth” a positive outlet, and has expanded to Montgomery Middle School.

PRYDE School Sites and Enrollment:

Chesterton Elementary - 35 students

Linda Vista Elementary - 45 students

Kit Carson Elementary - 48 students

Montgomery Middle - 40 students



****All the costs associated with the community outreach programs described above – including transportation, staffing, materials, etc. – are funded 100% from our Annual Support Campaign and interest earned on a portion of our endowment funds. The programs operate at no cost to the schools or the students. “Graduates” of each program receive a free, one year youth membership to Mission Valley YMCA.****

In addition to our PRYDE and Outreach programs, our two biggest community outreach programs, Mission Valley YMCA, in cooperation with the Downtown YMCA, organizes Career Luncheons for two middle schools, Mar Vista and Montgomery. Each school year, close to 480 students are competitively selected to participate in several luncheons designed to encourage interaction between the students and area business professionals (screened and selected by the YMCA), with an eye towards identifying career paths and educational choices.



Membership:

We currently serve 30,033 members, with more than 4,000 members passing through one of our three locations each day.

Financial Assistance:

In 2008 financial assistance was used to assist 12,500 youth and families at a value of \$1.4 million. This includes subsidized memberships and programming.

Promotion Opportunities:

As we continue to grow our membership and increase our visibility throughout the community, a number of opportunities arise for trusted partners to gain positive exposure in the communities we serve.

Primarily, our *Evening at the Y* (formerly “Evening in the Piazza”) fundraiser on October 10, 2009, provides an opportunity for your organization to support the programs and facilities of Mission Valley YMCA.
