LOCAL GROUPS BRIGHTEN HOLIDAYS FOR MORE THAN 75 FAMILIES

SAN DIEGO, CA – Kids and families in Linda Vista will get an early Christmas this year, thanks to two local nonprofits with a history of helping those who need it most.

Children and families participating in the Y's after-school drug and violence prevention program (P.R.Y.D.E. Program) will gather at Bayside Community Center from 2:30 p.m. to 5 p.m., December 15, for a Holiday Winter Carnival, which will culminate in bags of groceries for the families and gifts for the children.

The participating families have children attending either Linda Vista Elementary or Carson Elementary, and the students participate in the Y's after-school program after being identified by the principal at each school as "at-risk." The gifts they receive have all been donated by YMCA members, staff, volunteers and partners in the community.
