## POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

- Parents must stay on the premises at all times and must let staff know where they will be located.
- Picture ID is required at all times. If you do not have a membership card, you will be required to show another form of ID and proof of a family membership.
- The parent who signs the child in must be the one to sign the child out. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Maximum time limit is two hours. A grace period of five minutes will apply for families that have children in both Child Watch and Kids Club.
- NO CELL PHONES, electronics, food or personal items — with the exception of books and homework — allowed in Kids Club at any time.
- Parents will be notified immediately about behavioral concerns. Depending on the severity, the child may be asked to leave or can be suspended for up to a month. Staff may use timeouts as a form of discipline; one minute per year of age.
- Notify staff at time of check-in if your child has allergies.
- Children are asked to pick up after themselves prior to leaving.
- Sick children are not allowed in Kids Club. If your child has a runny nose, cough or fever, you will be asked to take him or her home (all illnesses are determined at staff's discretion).
- This program is for children ages 6-12 years. Children with siblings will be checked in separately between Child Watch and Kids Club.
