COMMUNITY OUTREACH PROGRAMS

P.E. OUTREACH

Mission Valley YMCA’s Physical Education Outreach Program reaches more than 2,300 students during the school day, providing them with opportunities like free swim and gymnastics lessons. The students are bussed to the YMCA, participate in activities, and are taken back to school.

PRYDE

The PRYDE (Prevention, Recreation, Youth, Diversity, Education) Program serves more than 175 kids through after-school programming targeted to children most at-risk.

PRYDE School Sites and Enrollment:

Linda Vista Elementary	36 students
Kit Carson Elementary	48 students
Montgomery Middle	75 students

All costs associated with the community outreach programs described above – including transportation, staffing, materials, etc. – are funded 100% from our Annual Support Campaign and interest earned on a portion of our endowment funds. The programs operate at no cost to the schools or the students. “Graduates” of each program receive a free, one year youth membership to Mission Valley YMCA.

CAREER LUNCHES

Mission Valley YMCA, in cooperation with the Downtown YMCA, organizes Career Luncheons for Mar Vista and Montgomery Middle Schools. Each school year, close to 480 students are competitively selected to participate in several events designed to encourage interaction between the students and carefully screened business professionals with an eye towards identifying career paths and educational choices.



CYMER COMPUTER CLUBHOUSE

Thanks to a generous donation of more than \$450,000 over 5 years from Cymer, Inc., Mission Valley YMCA hosts a Computer Clubhouse, one of only 100 around the globe. The Clubhouse features 21st Century hardware and software – including a mobile sound studio and audio/video editing software – that will allow deserving youth to explore their creativity through audio, visual, and print mediums. The Clubhouse is free to dozens of teenagers who would otherwise have no access to a state-of-the-art program like this.



MEMBERSHIP

We currently serve 30,000 members, with more than 4,000 people passing through one of our three locations each day.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

In 2010, financial assistance was used to assist 13,600 youth and families at a value of \$1.44 million. This includes subsidized memberships and programming.

FACILITIES

Mission Valley YMCA is comprised of three locations:

-Toby Wells YMCA	5105 Overland Avenue	Opened in August 2005

CHILDCARE/AFTERSCHOOL

In addition, we also partner with several school sites to provide childcare and after school programs:

- 5 **PrimeTime sites**, San Diego Unified School District's after-school programs), serving 500 youth.
- 5 licensed, **Character Builders** sites for before and after school childcare, serving 320 youth.
